TRAMCARS

Car 53 Work is progressing at a steady rate on 53. The interior has been re-floored and the longitudinal seating is currently being fitted. On the top deck railings have been fitted. The upstairs "swing" seats were completed some time ago and are ready for fitting.

Car 225 is currently decked out in fairy lights and has wooden figures and Christmas trees etc. fastened to both sides and ends.

Car 1017 has been extensively covered by tarpaulin due to severe rain penetration at both platforms.

Car 9062 is continuing to receive new window rubbers. Many of the old rubbers are in very bad condition which hold water causing body corrosion. If any member has experience in bus/coach/tram glazing their help would be **greatly** appreciated. Summerlee electricians have fitted a full size Bruxelles controller at No. 2 end similar to that of No. 1 end. Air brakes will also be added at this end. The double-ending of the car is to enable 9062 to run efficiently on the extension.
